

Dutchess Heritage Quilt Show XIII –October 6-7 2007

Bag Entry Instructions

Please retain this instruction sheet! It contains important information about entry, delivery and bag pick-up.

1. Each item entered in our show requires a registration form. You may copy the enclosed form, download the form from our web site (www.dhquiltshow.org) or call Georgiana Garrison at (845) 635-3969

The registration deadline is **Thursday, September 20, 2007**. If space is filled prior to that date, your entry may not be accepted. Include with your form(s), a color photograph of each bag and a SASE business size envelope. There is a limit of 5 entries per person. Photographs are needed for security and exhibition design purposes and will be returned. The quality of the photo is not important and the bag need not be finished in the photo.

Please adhere to the following challenge rules:

1. Bag itself must be made by entrant.
2. Some fabric should be incorporated into the bag.
3. The bag should be no larger than 18" in any direction, excluding handle.
4. Bag must be functional.
5. Bag must have some form of quilting incorporated on it. (applique, patchwork, etc.)
6. Any shade of blue must be used in some form on the bag. (fabric, stitchery, embellishments, etc.)
7. All embellishments must be firmly attached.
8. Entrants name and address should be firmly attached to inside of bag.

Bags may be delivered via US mail, UPS or in person. A claim check will be provided for each entry and will need to be presented when you pick up your bag(s).

DHQS will take every reasonable precaution to safeguard bags in their custody, including 24-hour security at DCC during the show. However, we cannot be responsible for accidental damage or loss of entered bag(s).

BAGS SENT BY MAIL OR UPS

1. Bags sent by mail or United Parcel Service must be shipped so as to arrive no later than Friday, September 21, 2007. Please use the address above to send bags to Georgiana Garrison.
2. Make sure that your bag is packed appropriately, inside a sturdy carton. Include your name and address inside the carton.
3. For each bag sent by mail or UPS, include instructions for return along with an address label and a check payable to Dutchess Heritage Quilt show for the amount of the return postage. UPS automatically insures your package for up to \$100. If you require a higher amount, you will need to arrange this with your shipper.

BAGS DELIVERED PERSONALLY

1. Bags will be accepted either of 2 times and locations
 1. Tuesday, September 18, 2007 from 6-7 PM at the Northern Star Quilt Guild Meeting at JFK High School on Route 138 in Somers NY
 2. Saturday, September 29, 2007 from 10 am to 4 PM at the home of Karen Abramson, 240 Creek Road, Poughkeepsie NY (845) 452-2468

These will be the only days for receipt of personally delivered Bags!

Travel directions to Karen Abramson's: **From Poughkeepsie and South or West**, take Route 9 North to the intersection of Fulton Street. This is directly across from the main entrance to Marist College. Turn right onto Fulton St. and proceed straight to the end (Route 9G, also known as Violet Ave.) Turns left on Violet Ave. and continue past the flashing light at the firehouse to the next traffic light. The department of Transportation will be on

your right. Turn right at this light onto Cottage St., continue past the DCC entrance to the end (Creek Road) Turn left onto Creek Road and Abramson's house is the fourth on the right, down the long driveway.

From north of Poughkeepsie, take Route 9 south to the intersection of Fulton St. (across from Marist College) turn left on Fulton St. and proceed as above.

Or, **from Southeast of Poughkeepsie** of Poughkeepsie, take Route 44/55 to Innis Ave north to the end at the traffic light at Salt Point Turnpike. Turn Left at this light and take the first right onto Little St. George. Make an immediate right onto Creek Rd. Continue on Creek past DCC. After the intersection of Cottage St. #240 is the 4th driveway on the right.

2. Upon receipt of your bag, you will be given (or mailed) a Bag Receipt card. Please keep this card, as it will serve as your claim check and must be presented when you pick up your bag after the show.

BAG RETURN

All Bag will remain on display throughout the show. Pick up will be at Falcon Hall, Dutchess Community College (DCC), on Sunday October 7, 2007 between 5:15 and 6:15. All bags for which return shipping arrangements were made will be shipped during the week following the show.

Please adhere to these procedures to enable proper handling of your entry. Your signature on the registration signifies your agreement to the above rules.
