

Dutchess Heritage Quilt Show XV – October 8 & 9, 2011

Apron Entry Instructions

Please retain this instruction sheet! It contains important information about entry, delivery and apron pick-up.

1. Each item entered in our show requires a registration form. You may copy the enclosed form, download the form from our web site (www.dhquiltshow.org) or call Kathryn Lange at (845) 249-5168 or email DHQSchallenge@yahoo.com

The registration deadline is **Thursday, September 22, 2011**. If space is filled prior to that date, your entry may not be accepted. Include with your form(s), a color photograph of each apron and a SASE business size envelope. There is a limit of 5 entries per person. Photographs are needed for security and exhibition design purposes and will be returned. The quality of the photo is not important and the apron need not be finished in the photo.

Please adhere to the following challenge rules:

1. Apron itself must be made by entrant.
2. The apron construction can be creative, original, retro, modern, etc. It may not be a purchased, pre-made apron of any sort.
3. The apron must be functional.
4. The apron may be made from fabric, unusual materials, found objects, etc.
5. All embellishments must be firmly attached.
6. Entrants name and address should be firmly attached to inside of the apron.

Aprons may be delivered via US mail, UPS or in person. A claim check will be provided for each entry and will need to be presented when you pick up your apron(s). It is recommended that you use a tracking number.

DHQS will take every reasonable precaution to safeguard aprons in their custody, including 24-hour security at DCC during the show. However, we cannot be responsible for accidental damage or loss of entered apron(s).

APRONS SENT BY MAIL OR UPS

1. Aprons sent by mail or United Parcel Service must be shipped so as to arrive no later than Wednesday, September 28, 2011. Please use the address above to send aprons to Kate Lange.
2. Make sure that your apron is packed appropriately, inside a sturdy carton. Include your name and address inside the carton.
3. For each apron sent by mail or UPS, include instructions for return along with an address label and a check payable to Dutchess Heritage Quilt show for the amount of the return postage. UPS automatically insures your package for up to \$100. If you require a higher amount, you will need to arrange this with your shipper.

APRONS DELIVERED PERSONALLY

1. Aprons will be accepted at the following location
Saturday, October 1, 2011 from 10 AM to 4 PM at the home of
Karen Abramson, 240 Creek Road, Poughkeepsie NY (845) 452-2468

This will be the only day for receipt of personally delivered Aprons!

Travel directions to Karen Abramson's: **From Poughkeepsie and South or West**, take Route 9 North to the intersection of Fulton Street. This is directly across from the main entrance to Marist College. Turn right onto Fulton St. and proceed straight to the end (Route 9G, also known as Violet Ave.) Turns left on Violet Ave. and continue past the flashing light at the firehouse to the next traffic light. The department of Transportation will be on

your right. Turn right at this light onto Cottage St., continue past the DCC entrance to the end (Creek Road) Turn left onto Creek Road and Abramson's house is the fourth on the right, down the long driveway.

From north of Poughkeepsie, take Route 9 south to the intersection of Fulton St. (across from Marist College) turn left on Fulton St. and proceed as above.

Or, **from Southeast of Poughkeepsie** of Poughkeepsie, take Route 44/55 to Innis Ave north to the end at the traffic light at Salt Point Turnpike. Turn Left at this light and take the first right onto Little St. George. Make an immediate right onto Creek Rd. Continue on Creek past DCC. After the intersection of Cottage St. #240 is the 4th driveway on the right.

2. Upon receipt of your apron, you will be given (or mailed) an Apron Receipt card. Please keep this card, as it will serve as your claim check and must be presented when you pick up your apron after the show.

APRON RETURN

All Aprons will remain on display throughout the show. Pick up will be at Falcon Hall, Dutchess Community College (DCC), on Sunday October 9, 2011 between 5:15 and 6:15. All aprons for which return shipping arrangements were made will be shipped during the week following the show.

Please adhere to these procedures to enable proper handling of your entry. Your signature on the registration signifies your agreement to the above rules.
